

## Lynn Cline's Addendum

The final report represents a significant amount of time, effort, and candid discussion by each member of the research group. I believe it is a good report. One area in which we had some difficulty in achieving consensus was the sub-section in the Services section of the report, entitled "Larger Contextual Issues". In my view the second, third, and fourth contextual issues do not follow from the report, i.e., I see no direct evidence from what we studied to posit those issues. As a result, I am somewhat uncomfortable asserting them as part of the report. What might be more appropriate would be if the group were to externally suggest or recommend these in a "by the way" or "while we're discussing this" frame of mind. They are all issues that should probably be discussed but not in the context of having been a finding in the report. And, I am still not in agreement that we can assume the validity of the third assumption, though it is certainly worth discussing.
